POLAR EXPLORERS

Phonics

We will be continuing our 'Little Wandle' journey and learning the digraphs and trigraphs: ai ee igh oa oo oo ar or ur ow oi ear air and er. We will continue to learn tricky words.

Maths

We will continue to develop our subitising and counting skills and explore the composition of numbers within and beyond 5.

Expressive Art and Design

We will explore animal prints and replicate these with different media. We will also design homes for hibernating animals.

Communication and language

We will learn to describe events in detail and listen to stories to build familiarity and understanding.

Reading

We will continue to read our 'Little Wandle' books in class to consolidate our phonic learning and enjoy a range of books through drawing club such as 'Keith the cat with the magic hat' and 'Dear zoo'.
