POLAR EXPLORERS

Phonics

We will be continuing our Little Wandle journey and reviewing all the graphemes we have learnt throughout the year. We will learn to read words with 2 or 3 digraphs and longer words ending in 'ing', 's' and 'es'.

Reading

We will be reading stories from other cultures such as 'We're going on a lion hunt' and adventure stories such as 'The snail and the whale'.

Writing

We will practise writing sentences with known graphemes and tricky words. We will use finger spaces and full stops in our writing and begin to use capital letters.

Maths

We will consolidate our counting skills, count to larger numbers and develop a wider range of counting strategies.

We will copy and continue patterns and look for patterns in our environment.

PSED

We will discuss how we are different to our friends and family members and how lives of people living in other countries are different to our own.

Communication and Language

We will make comparisons and talk about how our lives might be different to others.

Physical development

We will continue working on both our fine and gross motor skills. We will practise events for sports day and using scissors to cut straight lines and curved objects.

Expressive art and design

We will learn a traditional African dance and create our own aboriginal art.

Understanding the world

We will look at transport in other countries and how children travel to school.
