Phonics

We will be continuing our 'Little Wandle' journey and learning the digraphs and trigraphs: ai ee igh oa oo 00 ar or ur ow oi ear air and er. We will continue to learn tricky words and words with double letters.

Reading

We will continue to read our Little Wandle' books in class to consolidate our phonic learning and enjoy a range of books through drawing club such as 'The Little Red Hen' and 'Rosie's Walk'.

Writing

We will practise writing sentences with the dominant sounds and tricky words we hear and we will use finger spaces and full stops in our writing too.

Maths

We will continue to develop our subitising and counting skills and explore the composition of numbers within and beyond 5.

Personal. Social and Emotional development

We will be working on the topic 'Me and my world' in PSED and think about the different places and features of our neighbourhood.

Communication and Language.

We will learn to describe events in detail and listen to stories to build familiarity and understanding.
