. We are particularly interested in hardy, low-maintenance plants that will thrive outdoors. Donations can be brought into school and given to Mrs Tuck in the school office.

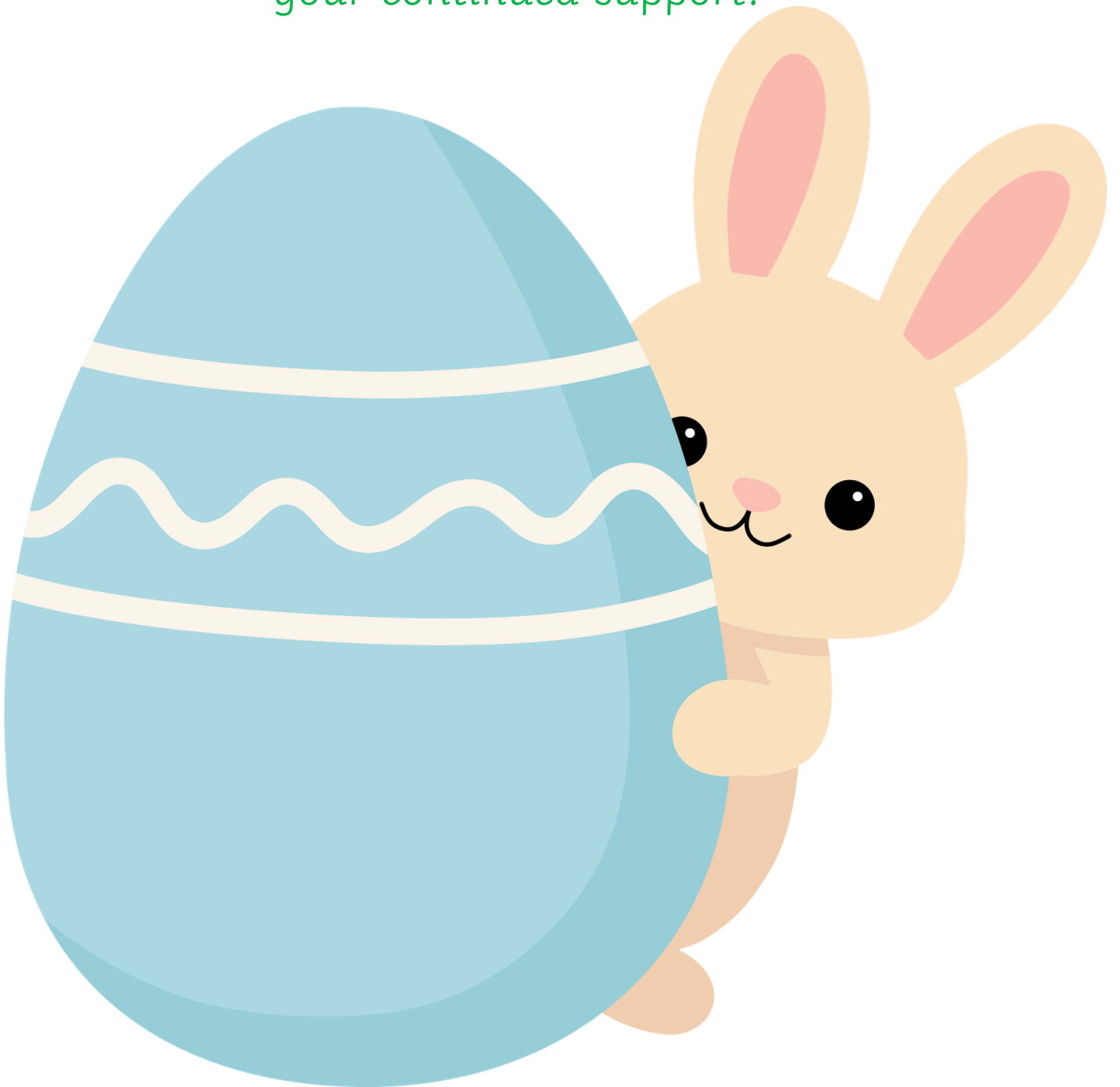
