

### Spelling

We will be ensuring our year 5/6 statutory spellings are secure.

### Reading

We will be reading *The Unforgotten Coat*, *Skellig* and *Dare to be You*. Children will continue to develop comprehension skills in daily reading lessons.

### Writing

Pupils will learn how to develop dialogue, write an explanation text and extend their narrative writing skills.

### Maths

We will cover algebra, angles, ratio, statistics, time and Roman Numerals. Children will develop reasoning skills and Y6 pupils will prepare for SATs.

### Science

Pupils will be learning about living things and their habitats and evolution and inheritance.

### History

We will be learning about the role and impact of 5 monarchs through time. Children will develop their historical skills and their knowledge of chronology.

### Geography

Pupils will compare regions in the UK with Europe and America. They will develop orienteering skills.

### Religion & World Views

We will discuss why there is suffering in the world and whether religion has a place in our world today? Children will consider how this links to scripture.

### PSHE

Children will be learning how to cope with changes in their emotions as they grow and change. and will further develop their knowledge about Relationships and Sex education ..

### Design Technology

The class will create a steady hand game using electrical systems.

### Music

We will be studying tempo and volume and create our own leavers' song. We will also be working hard to prepare an end of term performance.

### Computing

The children will learn how to collect data and how to create spreadsheets.

### PE
