LEARNING SUMMARY



Spelling/Phonics

This term we will be focusing on learning the year 5/6 statutory spellings.

Reading

We will look at inference, retrieval techniques and sequencing skills in Rooftoppers and Boy in the Tower texts.

Writing

In the first half term we will write based upon Rooftoppers and the second half term we will write based upon Boy in the Tower.

Maths

We shall study decimals, fractions and percentages alongside multiplication techniques and angles with shape.

Science

We shall study forces followed by animals and humans.

History

We will be looking at what impact the Mayas had on the world and what they invented.

Geography

Our unit will cover map reading and location using 4 and 6 figure grid references.

Religion&World Views

Our topics will discuss why it is better to witness an event in person and why there is suffering in the world.

Art

We will study architecture and how the printing techniques are used to aid drawing buildings.

Design Technology

We will be designing electronic doodlers, then stuffed toys followed by monitoring devices.

Music

Our first compositions will be based upon South Africa, then we will study music inspired by Holi - the festival of colour.

PSHE

We shall firstly learn about diversity in the community, then how to manage our life safely and finally e-safety online.

Computing

Our first unit will be a coding unit, then we will create data spreadsheets.

PE

In class PE, we will learn how to play Netball and then refine our attack and defense skills in invasion games. POSH will be teaching how to play Basketball and then Tag Rugby.

French

We will be learning the names of our family members followed by the names of clothing.
